What is VET-CERT?

Quality Managers in Initial Vocational Education and Training (IVET) and in Continuing Vocational Education and Training (CVET) work with important and challenging issues. To meet the challenges of Quality Management high level professional and personal competences are required.

VET-CERT is one of the Leonardo da Vinci/EQAVET projects with five national and three international partners. It aims to make a contribution to the further professionalization of Quality Managers by developing guiding recommendations for Competence Profiles as well as for supportive training models.

The aim of the Certification Concept is to develop a model whereby prior acquired competences of the Quality Personnel will be made transparent and recognized.
